This notice informs **Waitaki Biosciences a division of Pharmazen Limited** that the registration of the risk management programme with the official identification number **PH3/01** is subject to the following condition(s):

- 1. The Operator must provide the MPI Appointment and Approvals group with a written report from a recognized evaluator confirming that confirmation of validity has been completed in accordance with the previously evaluated documented protocol for thermal treatment of meat and thermal re-processing of contaminated dry product. The report must make appropriate recommendations with regard to the ongoing acceptability of the risk management programme subsequent to the completion of confirmation of validity.
- 2. Any product that does meet the IPCs documented in the RMP must be disposed of in accordance with company product disposal procedures.
- 3. The operator must provide the MPI Approvals group with a written report from a recognised evaluator confirming that confirmation of validity for receiving live BMS, crushing, separating and freezing the meat extract has been completed in accordance with the previously evaluated documented protocols.

The operator must provide the MPI Approvals group with a written report from a recognised evaluator confirming that confirmation of validity for solvent extraction of Listeria and E.Coli contaminated mussel has been completed in accordance with the previously evaluated documented protocols.

The reports must make appropriate recommendations with regard to the ongoing acceptability of the registered risk management programme subsequent to the completion of confirmation of validities.
